The only directly relevant materials that I can draw your attention to are postings on Julian Baker's Functional Fascia website, I have not had any direct dealings with him for a number of years. The first posting is: <https://functionalfascia.com>. Scroll down to the section headed Julian Baker. You will see that he claims that I **guided and advised him**, when the facts are that he hired facilities to run courses in my Departments at St. George's and Imperial. Imperial College **has not allowed him to run courses on its premises for about 6 years**. The legal department at Imperial have asked him to take down the posting about myself and Imperial College, because it implies our endorsement of his activities. Julian Baker has refused to take down the posting. You will also see text purporting to be endorsements from Debra Patten and Ian Scott. They have told me that they have not authorised any endorsements and that Julian Baker is **not longer allowed courses at their institutions**. I strongly suspect the other apparent endorsements have not been authorised either.

The second posting <https://functionalfascia.com/homepage/professor-ceri-davies/> is frankly libellous and without foundation. **I have not accused him of criminal activity or made false allegations about him.** I do not have a disturbance of mind and I have not made defamatory statements about him or shown him any unreasonable behaviour. However, I understand that the opposite is true, he has made serious allegations about me to the Medical Council of Ireland and the Scottish Government, which have been investigated and dismissed. I have not personally blocked a class of his in Ireland, this decision was made by the Medical Council of Ireland, because it would have **been against Irish law**. This posting has been live for a considerable time and although he states that he will publish details of the alleged correspondence 'very soon', they have not been forthcoming. My College's legal department has advised me not to enter into any communication with Julian Baker and I have taken its advice.
